Reconciliation: Saturday, 3:00 - 3:45 p.m. or by appointment.


Marriage: Arrangements must be made at least six months in advance with a priest or deacon.



The more we accept and understand this, the more clearly we communicate it to our loved ones, not necessarily with words, but always with the joyous brilliant light that comes from our own relationship with God, tended and cared for in the community of the Church." This quote certainly captures the importance of our witness to one another as we discover different ways to leave our footprints of kindness behind through service opportunities.

A lion's roar goes out in welcome to both our new faculty members and our new children and their families joining St. Mark this year in grades 1-8, as well as all our Kindergarten and PreK families.
