Reconciliation: Saturday, 3:00 - 3:45 p.m. or by appointment.


Marriage: Arrangements must be made at least six months in advance with a priest or deacon.

New Parishioners: All are welcome to join us by calling the office or visiting the website to schedule an appointment.



SCHOOL NEWS

St. Mark School Registration for 2022-2023

Registration for the 2022-2023 school year will begin on Monday, January 10, 2022, for all returning families and returning families with new student(s) going into Preschool or Kindergarten.

Registration will take place using your Digital Academy account. The Digital Academy link can also be found on the school website's main page. Priority registration concludes Saturday, January 22, 2022.

Open registration for new families to St. Mark School entering Pre-school-8 will begin Sunday, January 23, 2022. Registration will take place through the Digital Academy link on the school website's main page. Interested families may arrange a private tour by contacting the school office at 216-521-4115.



St. Mark School Open House will take place on Sunday, January 30, 2022, between 9:30-11:30.

Prospective new families will have the opportunity to tour the school and meet the classroom teachers.

VIRTUS COMPLIANCY — IMPORTANT

The USCCB (United States Conference of Catholic Bishops) will be doing on-site audits at parishes in the Diocese of Cleveland. It is imperative that prior to working with children - coaches, scout leaders and helpers, St. Mark Staff, catechists & teachers (PSR and DAY school), parent volunteers, etc. - are Virtus compliant. This means that one must be:

- Virtus trained (see below)
- Current with reading on-line bulletins
- Read and signed off on Policy for Protecting Children Revised 2016 (turn into Parish Office)
- Read and signed off on Standards of Conduct Revised 2016 (turn into Parish Office)
- New registrations for volunteers must complete a Background Check through OBCI & I at a fingerprint location (Warren Village BMV must have cash or check) and have report submitted to the Church Office attention Fr. Adam Zajac. Current volunteers with a BCI report that is 5 years or older must now renew Background check through Virtus.org under tab "Toolbox" and go to Selection.com. Must have a credit card to complete this process.
- Filled out a St. Mark Volunteer Application (turn into Parish Office)

All of the above-mentioned requirements are mandatory. (You can check your compliancy by going to "Virtus.org", signing in, and clicking on the green 'Training' tab.) If you are not sure of your compliancy, call Cheryl Birchfield at the Parish Office (216-226-7577) and your compliancy will be verified. If one is not Virtus compliant, YOU MAY NOT WORK/VOLUNTEER WITH CHILDREN.

To see available Virtus training sessions please go to Virtusonline.org click on First Time Registrant, Begin Registration Process also available is List of Sessions, select the Cleveland Diocese. You MUST register to attend a session.
